

Tips on How to Navigate or Use the iPods..



Directions:

When you hold the iPod in your hands you will notice the circle with “Menu” at the top. To turn it on, hold down the > || symbol at the “6:00 clock” position. Press “Menu” as many times as you need until you see the list with “Music” “Video” etc. Place your finger lightly on the white circle and move clockwise until the blue line highlights the word “Video” then press the silver circle in the middle of white circle and you will see “Movies”, press the silver circle one more time and you will see the list of videos provided.

To select a video to view, again place your

finger lightly on the white circle and move in either direction to “scroll” through the listing.

Once the video you wish to view is highlighted in blue, press the silver circle and it will begin to play. Make sure your headphones or earbuds are plugged in. Once the movie is playing, you can adjust the volume by lightly moving your finger on the white circle again. Once the movie is playing, the double arrows on the right fast forward, and double arrows on the left will rewind. **Pause** is the bottom button >||.
