Course Description:

The intent of this course is to give support to participants as they extend their skills with technology. Participants will use lab time to complete a project or reach outlined goals using school software. Mini lessons will be directed by the needs of the participants as they complete projects. At this point in time staff has expressed interest in Getting to Know Your Device, Promethean/Smartboard software, PowerTeacherPro, Office 365, Google Docs, Google Sites, Google Classroom, Moodle, PLATO, Plickers, PlayPosit, Socrative, Kahoot, AnswerPad, AppleTV, AirDrop, etc. Areas to be covered are based on the needs of each individual. If you want to work with a technology not listed here, just let me know and I will try to help you out.

We will be using the Google Classroom to facilitate this class as we explore how teachers could use this online classroom environment in their own instruction.
