

## Movie License

The high school now has a LEGAL license to show movies that are not part of the curriculum. The guidelines from the company are pretty straightforward:

1. There can be no charge for showing a movie.
2. The movie title and studio name cannot be used to advertise to the general public but OK within the school building.
3. Movies cannot be altered or copied.
4. All showings must be done within the high school building.



Movies can be obtained from any legal source such as rental companies, personal collection, Netflix, or the library. Movies can be used for fund raising as long as there is no admission cost. Sale of snacks is permitted, along with other suggestions on the company web site.
