

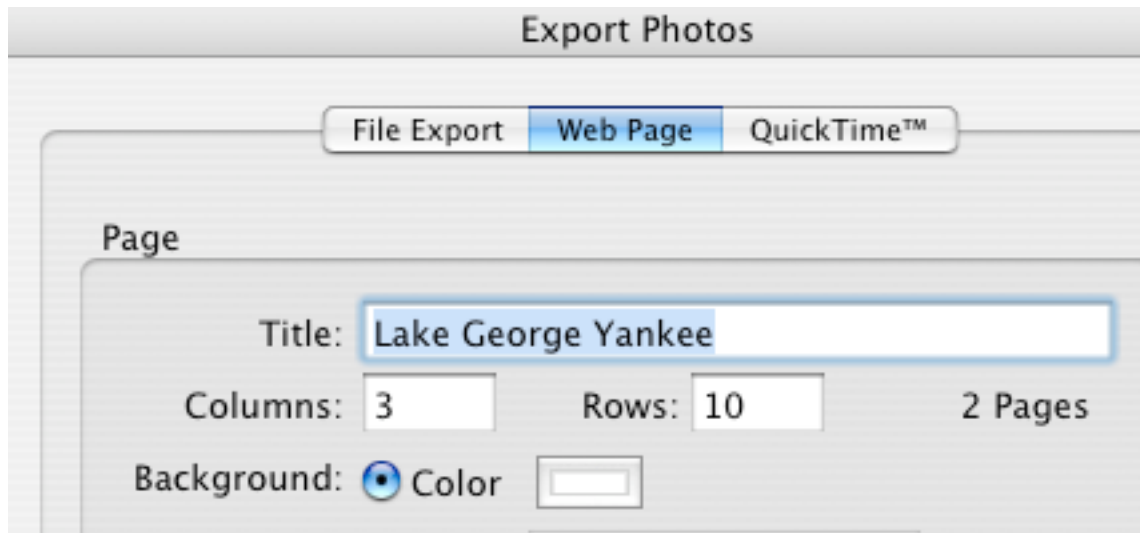
## How to Make a Webpage in iPhoto

To make a webpage in iPhoto first click on the album that you have created which contains the photos that you would like on the webpage.

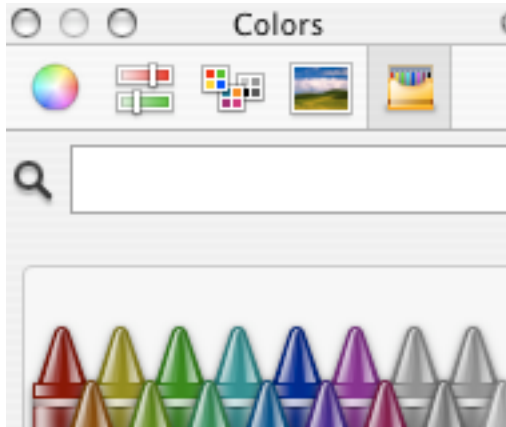


After selecting the album, highlight all the photos in the album by using the key command Apple+A (select all)

Next go up to *File* and scroll down to *Export* . You will see:



Here you select Web Page and the title of your album will appear. You can change it if you like. You can also change the background color and text color. When you hit Color, you may have to look under this menu to see the color selections. Just click on the bar above image (Export Photos) and click and drag it aside. You will see:



Here you can select the crayon or the spectrum to make a decision on the colors that you would like.

When you have finished color selection, hit *Export* at the lower right.

Make sure to navigate to your *SITES* folder and that is where all the files will be stored for this website.

### Viewing your page and making Captions:

You can view your page (s) on the Internet but cannot make captions under the photos unless you use Dreamweaver or another web design program.

Open Dreamweaver

Go up to File Open

Navigate to your Sites folder and select your web folder. You will see your webfolder and within it there will be an image folder, a Pages folder, a Thumbnail folder and one .html page and this html page is your index page.



After opening this page you can stretch the page by clicking on the lower right corner and dragging it. Now place your cursor to the right of a photo and press return. You can now add a caption. If the photo disappears, you need to press Edit Undo because you did not have the cursor in the right position. In Dreamweaver you can go to Edit Undo many times when correcting errors.
