REPORTING OF HAZARDS

In compliance with Chapter 22, Title 26, Maine Revised Statutes Annotated, 1984 Public Law, Chapter 826, Chemical Substance Identification Law, MSAD #54 will establish and maintain a site-based written Hazard Communication Program.

The written program will address, but not be limited to, the proper procedures for: labeling containers, obtaining and maintaining Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS), training employees to this subject, listing of hazardous substances, performing hazardous non-routine tasks, and informing contractors about potentially toxic or hazardous substances that they may be exposed to while at the work site.

A copy of the written Hazardous Communication Program, applicable MSDS sheets and lists of hazardous chemicals found in that specific school or program will be maintained in the main office of that specific school or program and in the Office of the Business Administrator. This information will be made readily available to all employees.
