## 1. 21st Century Grant Presentation

Dawn Fickett updated the committee on current after school programming at Skowhegan Area Middle School, Margaret Chase Smith School and Bloomfield Elementary School. The program is predominately funded by the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Schools Grant; the district is currently applying for a 4-year extension to the grant that would continue the program moving forward.

Dawn shared that data is collected annually to review the success of the program. Dawn reported that improvements were seen in both Literacy and Math scores at all three sites. The program also showed an overall decrease in classroom misbehavior, and an increase in classroom participation and homework completion by students involved.

Dawn shared a variety of experiences that students have had in the programs and plans to improve programs in the future. The committee thanked Dawn for her presentation.
