What you need to know before you visit:

- Appointments are available to Maine residents aged 18+ and will be given priority.
- To make an appointment, call the Community Vaccination Line at **1-888-445-4111** OR visit [VaccinateME.Maine.gov](https://www.vaccinateME.Maine.gov).
- Drop-in vaccinations will be available, first come, first served.
- This clinic is offering the Janssen, or J&J vaccine (one-dose), so a second appointment is not necessary.
